

2008 Raystown Lake DMAP Program Instructions

DMAP Area 89

- DMAP coupons will be made available on a first-come, first-served basis at the Visitor Center, Seven Points Area, Hesston, PA starting on **Saturday, August 9, 2009** from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Individuals may register for two coupons for themselves and one other person, provided they have the name, address and phone number of the second individual. **No more than two coupons per applicant will be distributed.** Back tag information is not required to receive the coupon.
- Coupons will also be distributed on **Sunday, August 10th** from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and continue seven days a week until the coupons are exhausted at the Seven Points Visitor Center.
- 1,200 DMAP coupons have been allocated for the 2008/2009 hunting season. Each applicant will receive a map and general rules on the DMAP program. Participants who did not report in 2007 or did not redeem their coupon should not apply for a 2008 DMAP.
- **NOTICE!!!** New for 2008. Areas removed from DMAP include the western side of the lake including hunting areas know as Bowser's Orchard, Seven Points, Old Loggers Trail, Upper Corners, Mitigation Area, Brumbaugh, Fouse's Crossing, James Creek, High Germany, Clappers Ridge, and Gate 35. These areas will continue to be open for all hunting activities and hunters may continue to harvest does using a 4A tag and bucks using their antlered tag.
- It is illegal to receive a coupon and not redeem it for a DMAP license. Coupons received from the Corps must be sent to the **Pennsylvania Game Commission with a \$10 check for residents and \$35 for non-residents.**
- Email and phone requests will not be accepted.
- Once the coupon is received from the Corps, the Corps can not replace a coupon and does not have access to information regarding status of license applications or reporting. Reporting is mandatory, but the Corps can not provide information or replace report cards. Information regarding status or reporting must be directed to the PA Game Commission at 717-787-5529.

Mail-in requests will also be permitted.

- Mail-in applications may include a request for **two** DMAP coupon per person and **must be post-marked after August 4th**. **No more than 2 coupons may be requested.**
- Mail-in requests must contain the name, address and phone number of the individual and include a **self addressed, stamped** return envelope for each applicant.. **Only business size return envelopes will be accepted (4 1/8" x 9 1/2").**
- Mail-in requests should be sent to **DMAP**, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Raystown Lake, 6145 Seven Points Road, Hesston, Pa. 16647.
- Requests **postmarked prior to the 4th of August** will be placed at the end of the list.

Deer Management Visitor Center Program

- The natural resource staff at Raystown Lake will be presenting a program on Deer Management at Raystown Lake. The presentation will be held at the Seven Points Visitor Center on Saturday, August 2nd at 7:00 PM. The program will include results of the previous FLIR aerial imaging deer surveys, harvest results, changes to the 2008 DMAP program, hunting access and gate openings along with descriptions of habitat programs that are improving habitat for deer.
