## **Elimination of Day Use Fees – Raystown Lake**

**RAYSTOWN LAKE, Pa.** — The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers at Raystown Lake announces that visitors to the lake will no longer need to pay day use fees for the use of launch ramps at the project. This action takes effect immediately. The lake will continue to charge fees for camping and picnic shelters. Dwight Beall, Operations Manager at Raystown indicated that the day use fee program, established in the mid 1990s is no longer cost effective to administer. Beall noted that in view of leaner budget times, the program's labor intensive costs are better put to use in higher priority areas serving the public.

People who purchased annual passes in association with Raystown's day use fee program are not eligible to receive refunds. However, annual passes are still valid at other Corps projects across the country where day use fees are charged.
