Raystown Lake temporarily closes boat launch

RAYSTOWN LAKE, Pa. — The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers at Raystown Lake will close Snyder's Run Boat Launch beginning April 9, to allow construction crews the opportunity to perform repairs to the boat ramp and adjacent roadway surface.

Lake officials anticipate the recreation area should only remain closed for a maximum of two weeks, weather permitting, and will reopen Snyder's Run Boat Launch as soon as work is complete.

Park visitors can still gain access to Raystown Lake by using the boat launches at Seven Points, Aitch, James Creek, Tatman Run, Shy Beaver and Weaver Falls.
